School Placement under Covid-19 – possibilities for digital ways to welcome students in classes

(project with Driestar University NL and KPH Vienna/Krems)

Facts

- The KPH Vienna/Krems and Driestar University in Holland have a regular student exchange for a whole week in autumn.
- Weekly program:
 - Lectures
 - School placement
 - observe the regular classes using standardized observation manuals,
 - start to plan lessons on their own together with the head teacher of the class and
 - at the last day – teach in class.
 - Reflection phases
 - excursion
- To allow this, the students stay in contact with the head teacher even prior to their visit online – also in times pre Covid-19.




Covid 19 – COIL Project

- June 2020 – online meeting with lectures from Driestar and Vienna (including metor)
- October 2020 – presentation of COIL project to the students and choice of course
- October / November 2020 – 3 online sessions (lectures about school system, Austrian history, multi level classes)



Covid 19 – COIL Project

- November 2020: Observation of the class via online connection



Covid 19 – COIL Project

- December 2020: Online Lecture
 - Worksheets and instructions for the handicraft tasks were sent by email, copied in Vienna and distributed to the children
 - Timeframe: 90min online lecture, break of 30min, 60minonline lecture



Blended intensive programmes


- New program under Erasmus+ 2021-2027
- physical mobility supplemented by a mandatory virtual component
 - physical stay: 5 - 30 days
 - Virtual component: planned meeting of all participants - online learning exchange & teamwork
 - Credit for both components: at least 3 ECTS
- BIP should have added value compared to the regular rates

International component of 131 promotion

Funding rates for mobilities in partner countries are higher than for stays within the program countries

Students: 700 euros / month

Personnel: 180 euros / day for day 1-14
