
The European University of the Seas (SEA-EU)
Was officially launched in October 2019 as part of the flagship European University Initiative.

It was created as an alliance of 6 universities that share a close link to the seas as an essential feature.

In 2023, SEA-EU welcomed **3 new members**, bringing the total number of universities involved to 9. Together with **more than 75 stakeholders**, they co-create the future of European Higher Education.
