Proposals for changes to the Statutes and the House Rules must be sent to the Secretary of ETEN vzw no later than 8 working days before the GA. Changes to the Statutes require a 2/3 majority vote.

***Statutes and House Rules - changes**

The Board proposes the following two changes to the ETEN vzw Statutes and House Rules:

1) Vote concerning the Statutes:

Board sitting period:

The board sitting period of the board members should be extended from a two-year period to a three-year period.

Motivation: A three-year period will give the board member longer time to get used to the board work and thus be able to participate more actively in the board work.

In the statutes it is stated:

Art. 20 appointment of the board

The general assembly appoints the board members.

The appointment is made by a simple majority of the votes cast, in a secret ballot. No attendance quorum is required.

The board members are appointed for a period of 2 years in accordance with the procedure described in the "House Rules".

The board suggests the following changes to the above:

The board members are appointed for a period of 3 years in accordance with the procedure described in the "House Rules".

2) Vote concerning the House Rules:**Number of Board members:**

The Board proposes that the number of Board members will be reduced to 4 members.

Motivation: The board is equally efficient with 4 members. Board travel expenses will be lower.

In the House Rules, it is stated:

The Board of ETEN has five members who have at least one specific role, including the Chair, Vice-Chair, Treasurer, Secretary, Legal Liaison, and TIG-leaders and ECO Coordinators. In some cases, one individual may take on two roles and some roles may be shared by two members.

The board suggests the following changes to the House Rules:

The Board of ETEN has four members who have at least one specific role, including the Chair, Vice-Chair, Treasurer, Secretary, Legal Liaison, and TIG-leaders and ECO Coordinators. In some cases, one individual may take on two roles, and some roles may be shared by two members.

In case the above votes are approved by the GA, the board proposes the following changes of House Rules:

In the House Rules it is formulated:

Section III: Structure of ETEN

Article 15 - Organisation of the Executive Committee

*The Executive Committee of ETEN is called the Board of ETEN (or 'the Board'). To avoid a complete change of Board Members in any one year, generally, elections take place annually with **two** Board positions up for election **one year and the other three positions up for election the following year.***

The board suggests the following changes:

Section III: Structure of ETEN

Article 15 - Organisation of the Executive Committee

*The Executive Committee of ETEN is called the Board of ETEN (or 'the Board'). To avoid a complete change of Board Members in any one year, generally, elections take place **annually when ~~two~~ Board positions are up for election. A board member sits for three years.***
